ABJS President

Term: Elected position; serves a 1-year term in each office, advancing from Second Vice-President to First Vice-President to President, followed by 1-year terms as Immediate Past-President and Second Past-President.

Responsibilities:

- Serves as a voting member of the ABJS Board of Directors (BOD)
- Serves as a voting member of Trustees of Clinical Orthopaedics and Related Research (TCORR)
- Presides at all meetings of the ABJS BOD
- Has authority and responsibility for administration of the affairs of the ABJS, subject to the bylaws and orders of the ABJS BOD
- Advises and makes recommendations to the BOD regarding the operation of the ABJS
- Is an ex-officio member of all committees
- Serves as Chair of the Program Committee
- Presides at the annual meeting
- Attends ABJS BOD and TCORR meetings as required
- Attends *CORR*® Publishers Meeting during AAOS annual meeting or virtually when applicable
- Participates in Board of Directors and TCORR conference calls as required
- Serves as an ex-officio member of the Nominating Committee
- Delivers the President's Report at all BOD and members' business meetings
- Prepares agendas for all BOD and members' business meetings
